## The Skiing

Les Contamines-Montjoie has an enviable snow record. Because of its unique geographical position at the head of a valley beneath the Mont Blanc Massif it enjoys a long winter season and is a 'snowsure' resort.



Within the village there are 120km of groomed pistes. However, there are literally loads of powder fields which rarely get skied out, unlike larger resorts. These pistes are great for all levels of skiers.

We are 10 mins away from St Gervais where you can take a lift to Megeve or catch a train to Les Houches. The Evasive lift pass opens up 420km of on-piste skiing to you. If you're feeling really adventurous then the Mont Blanc pass allows you to ski the whole of the Chamonix valley plus the aforementioned ski areas. You probably need your own transport to make the most of this ski experience.
